- Entrepreneurships with Public Schools STEAM and STEM programs; Young Entrepreneur Academy








# History of Macon Rotary Club







#### Accomplishments of Macon Rotary Club

- o Built Rotary Park in celebration of the 100th Anniversary of Rotary in 2005
- Had 100% participation and exceeded our goal in the initial drive to eradicate polio, c. 1985.
- Changed our club constitution to admit women in 1994.
- Built Habitat House during Bob Hatcher's presidency.
- Sponsored a Georgia Rotary student every year since the program began in 1946.
- Produced 8 District Governors to lead our Rotary District.
- o Provided 400+ prosthetic legs for amputees in Vietnam during our club's 100th year.
- o Supported the <u>Leader in Me Program</u>

#### Accomplishments of Macon Rotary Club

- Sponsored the Downtown Macon Rotary Club and 7 other Rotary clubs.
- Listed in the first 100 Rotary Clubs (out of 32,000+ Rotary Clubs).
- Contributed over \$500,000 The Rotary Foundation.
- Provided leadership for the civic and cultural life of Macon for over 100 years.
- Sent Ambassadorial Scholars to study in other countries.
- Hosted Ambassadorial Scholars from other countries.
- Provided leaders and team members for Group Study Exchanges to other countries.
- Hosted Group Study Exchange teams from other countries.
- o Sent members to participate in Polio National Immunization Days in India and Pakistan.





**C.A.R.T. Funding/"Bragging"** – Put \$2 in the blue buckets on your table to brag on something personal or professional. Money goes to Alzheimer's Research


**Paul Harris Fellow** – Someone who has donated \$1000 to the Rotary Foundation. "Paul Harris +1" means they've donated \$2000.

Will Watt Fellow – Someone who has donated \$1000 to the Georgia Rotary Student Program (GRSP).

**Classification Talk** - A member sharing about their profession and the professional "Classification" they hold in the club.

**Rotary Foundation** – Each member is asked to donated at least \$100 to the Rotary Foundation each year. E.R.E.Y. means every Rotarian, every year. Each November we sit at "Birthday Tables" and people bring their \$100 check.

**Raffle** – Purchase a ticket when you sign in. If your ticket is drawn you will get the chance to draw a card from the deck. If you draw the Queen of Clubs you will receive half the pot of money. The other half goes to the Club.
